**Minutes**

- A discussion of fundraising events was held and the chart was created (see end of minutes for chart). The group discussed making the fundraising more accessible and visible for families possibly with a thermometer and the current goal that the money will fund. Group members want to research the current fundraising items (i.e. Raley's card, Escrip, Save-mart, etc.) to add to the website page the steps to take to sign up for the fundraisers. A discussion looked at how the money is deposited from the fundraisers and Mrs. Bariel will make sure the checks get to the business office.
- The Straw Hat and Quick Quack Car Wash item was tabled as Drina Black was not present to lead the discussion. This item will be placed on the December agenda.
- A discussion of T shirt sales resulted in the following ideas: shirts can be given as prizes in the Extravaganza raffle, sell shirts at new family orientation, before fieldtrips, and promote them before Westminster Woods field trip. The discussion was held about the actual cost of the shirts and it was determined they cost a range of \$5.89-\$17.49. The group thought they should be sold at near cost and prices should be checked. The group would like to hold a contest next year for a new T shirt design and offer a prize related to art like a Michael's gift certificate. Amber Gillespie said she might be able to get one donated.
- A discussion of the approved items that have yet to be purchased brought up that Maribel is already approved to buy containers for the vending machine food. In addition, a discussion was held as to whether the teachers would rather have an Elmo projector rather than an overhead. Mrs. Bariel will contact the teachers and find out. Kristie Williams said she could look into the name plates for the Advisor's offices as she has a contact in that area. New ideas were brought up such as refilling the NOEO science kits as parts are always missing. The science teachers just received science supplies for the classes and should not need the NOEO kits (not funded by CHAT\$). The PACT staff will do an assessment of the popularity of the kits and what items are

needed. Amber Gillespie volunteered to assist with the setting up and organization of the kits. Group members also thought that finding a way to block the view of the hallway on the Advisors' doors would be helpful to cut down on distractions in meetings. Window clings were suggested. A concern was brought up about the refrigerator in the warehouse and it's use for vending machine items.

- A discussion was held based on an email from Maria Haugseth (proposer) about the interest level and amount of money that parents are willing to pay. Based on her survey the parent payments would only cover about half of the cost and the group decided that it should be opened up to homeschooling families outside of PACT to help fund it and to have a positive public relations for PACT by providing this service.
- A discussion of the Teen Night found that we no longer need to pay for the site license for movies as PFAA's parent group paid for one for the whole school. The next item on the list was dropped ( Payment for site license). The ideas for Teen Night range from game night to movie, night with the possibility of having an early movie for younger students and a later movie for middle school students. Snacks would be sold for fundraising but the event would be free to all students. Kristie Williams is interested in getting this event started but would like assistance from other parents.
