- **Plan Straw Hat & Quick Quack Car Wash fundraising-** Planning a pizza night for 1/19/2011 from 6-8 PM and a party room will be reserved for PACT. Families will bring games to play, T-shirts may be given out as door prizes, and Tastie will visit. 20% of profits will be donated to the CHAT\$ group. Jackie will create a poster to put up around PACT before winter break and flyers to hand out to families and at the event, and email will also be sent out to families. Quick Quack Car Wash event will be scheduled in the spring.
- **Review and revise Fundraising Directory-** a copy will be emailed out to the group.
- **Discussion of T Shirt sales and plans for 2010-2011-** T-shirts will be sold at Winter Boutique for 1 for \$4, 2 for \$6, and \$2 for each after 2 and hoodies will be \$10. Shirts will be given to students and chaperones upon turning in their Westminster Woods money. There was talk of donating the remaining shirts to a shelter if the sizes are unsellable. Amber brought up Café Press where shirts can be ordered one at a time for the future. The group wanted to make sure that the phrase home school is on the new shirt design.
- **Discussion of spending from last year and items not yet purchased-** an overhead was already purchased for the teachers, the containers for the vending machine were purchased, Kristie will continue to work on name plates for the advisor offices. The group wanted to label all doors/rooms at PACT.
- **Development of Strong Willed Child Presentation and outreach to other schools update-** There has been no response from other home schools about the event. The group discussed that there is not enough interest at PACT to fund the program. We will look at it again in the spring.
- **Presentation, discussion, and voting on fund proposals-** no new proposals
- **Presentation/discussion of newly submitted fund proposals**
  - **Window clings for Advisor doors-** Advisors prefer their curtains or own design
  - **NOEO science kit replacement items-** We will get a list of families using curriculum from Brittany and Amber will put together kits. Dani may have a list of all NOEO kits and books.
  - **Drama production script fee \$200-** Paid for out of Duck Pluck funds
  - **Coupon books ordered for fundraising-** Jackie got Save Around Sacramento coupon books and members of the group took them to sell. The proceeds will fund the Brain Pop program for next year. The books are sold for \$20 and CHAT\$ makes a profit of \$8 for each book. The goal is to sell them by winter break.

**Non-agenda Items:**
