- Plan Quick Quack Car Wash fundraising (not discussed)
- Update on Straw Hat Fundraiser
 - Total raised \$27.75. More advertising needs to be done for the next event on 3/23. A greater focus on game night and advertising earlier and without an attachment in the email reminder.
- Sacramento Coupon Books Update
 - About 40 books have been sold and a few more are coming in soon.
- Sign-ups for parent fundraiser sign up crew for Hobbie and Collector's fair 2/24 and Extravaganza 5/19. (Proposed sign up and get a raffle ticket for Extravaganza)
 - Sign-ups were completed and discussion of advertising the game night, Escrip, and sell T-shirts.

- Presentation, discussion, and voting on fund proposals

 - The group thought this idea was good and would like to see her proposal for how she will determine the needs. They thought the Aquatic Center was a fieldtrip that could have been expanded. There is a need to open up more spots on fieldtrips to allow for more families to attend as waitlists are long this year.

Additional Topics:

- Class sign up process- The group discussed needs to revise the class sign up process/preferences and look at needs of middle school, writing, etc. A suggestion was made that classes be held off campus as the NCS main campus, a community room, or the local libraries.
